Bussenried

The Bussenried is located about 2 km north of Constance and is an artificially dammed water body in a reed area (see "Google Maps" below). The open water area measures about 300 X 100 m. It is a very shallow body of water with a water depth of about 1 m. Fallen trees and dead trees in the water characterize the area. It is therefore very similar to <u>Ulmisried</u>, which was also artificially dammed. There are extensive areas of reeds. It is difficult to reach because of a deep layer of mud on the bank. Sampling is actually only possible at the dammed end of Bussenried.
