Lauchsee Moor (Austria)

The Lauchsee Moor is the remains of a raised bog, just a few hundred meters from the Lauchsee. The Lauchsee is used as a bathing lake. The Lauchsee Moor lies at an altitude of 930 meters. Remnants of former drainage ditches are still present. There are many puddles with cotton grass (*Eriophorum angustifolium*) and the Venus flytrap (*Dionaea muscipula*) growing in between.
