

Mühlweiher Litzelstetten

The Mühlweiher Litzelstetten is an artificially created retention basin with dimensions of approx. 200 X 30 m, which is surrounded by forest. The pond was used as a mill pond and a fish pond. Since 2015 the Mühlweiher was not used for commercial purposes anymore and is now a protected area. The water surface is covered with white water lilies (*Nymphaea alba*) and frogsweed (*Luronium natans*) in summer. The pond has no inlet, but is fed by the infiltrated rainwater from the surrounding area.
